Greetings from Riverside,

We are excited about the things God is doing here at Riverside, and we are looking for a Christ centered staff that is committed to the Lord's service for Summer 2021. If you would like more information about what it looks like to work at camp, or to apply online, we encourage you to visit our summer employment page on our website (www.riversidelbc.org/apply) or call us with any questions you might have.

Enclosed is a cabin leader application form for you to complete and return to us via email or mail. In order to be considered for the position of cabin leader, the applicant must be at least one full year out of high school by the summer of 2021.

Please fill out the application accurately and honestly, and return it to us when it is complete. Be sure to list three references, as well as their contact information, before returning the application. Your three references should be individuals that would be able to give a complete evaluation of who you are. (Some good references would be a pastor, youth director, past employer, an adult friend of the family, etc. At least 1 of your references needs to be someone of the opposite sex.)

The deadline we have set for cabin leader applications is February 1. This means that your application needs to be postmarked by February 1, in order to be sure that we consider you for employment. It is our goal to finish interviews by the middle of February, and you will hear from us by mid-March in regards to the selection process. Applications we receive that are postmarked after February 1 will not be guaranteed consideration for employment, but may still be able to be hired based on need.

As a cabin leader, you would arrive for staff training on May 30. You would be earning a weekly salary of \$210 plus room and board. The cabin leader schedule is nine weeks during the summer plus two full weeks of training (May 30-June 11). The last day of camp is August 13.

Be sure to indicate any special skills or interests you have that are helpful for us as we consider your application. Please join us in praying for God's wisdom throughout this process. Thank you for your interest, and we look forward to hearing from you!

ABOUT RIVERSIDE



Riverside is located just a few miles north of Story City, IA. The camp has 123 acres along the beautiful shores of the South Skunk River. We are full of the love of Christ here. We are expectant about the work God will do in and through us each summer as He makes himself known in our lives.

TRADITIONAL CAMP: Campers stay in cabins with 2 cabin leaders and participate in everything on the main camp area. This includes chapel, Bible studies, big group games, God time, free time, outdoor and indoor rec activities, meals together, campfire, and a lot more.



RANCH CAMP: Our ranch camp program is a top notch, high quality, Christ centered camping experience which offers campers the unique opportunity to learn more about Christ while riding horses. Campers ride horses every day, while also participating in the main camp activities.

ADVENTURE CAMP: The Riverside adventure program encompasses all it means to appreciate God's beautiful creation through adventure! We offer experiences for Juniors, Junior High, and High School adventure campers. Depending on the age group, adventure offers experiences in team work, challenge course, creek stomping, cooking meals, camping, canoeing, hiking,

rock climbing, and more. Adventure is an awesome opportunity for experiencing Christ in God's creation!

WHAT CAN I LOOK FORWARD TO AS A SUMMER STAFF MEMBER? Our desire is that our summer staff would first and foremost walk away from the summer knowing more of our Father's heart, our Savior's life, and our Spirit's power. We want you to know more about the love of Christ. That is our number one goal. Our number two goal is that summer staff would be better equipped and able to share the love and heart of God with others. This is a program designed to help you grow in Christian leadership. At Riverside we are very intentional about spiritual development. We have structured discipleship all summer long, ranging from staff devotions, time alone with God, and personal one-on-one discipleship opportunities. It is our greatest desire for you not only to minister to others during the summer, but that you would come to know Christ in a deeper way in your personal life as well!

WHAT DO WE DO EACH WEEK? Each role at camp is different, but rewarding. Cabin leaders have responsibilities including helping with program events such as chapel, Bible studies, campfire, skits, pool, camp store, and art fun. Cabin leaders are also responsible for teaching and at times disciplining youth. Cabin leaders are also expected to be good role models by being appropriate in all things, at all times, and following all camp rules. Cabin leaders may occasionally find themselves on "support" staff. Support staff weeks are spent primarily working on maintenance or in the kitchen. During support weeks, all staff are expected to stay at camp and be involved in the programming each evening except a possible night off. As a cabin leader, you will be in a cabin of 8-12 youth with another cabin leader on site at Riverside for 5-8 weeks of the summer. You will also go on 1-3 day camps (similar to VBS) at various churches across Iowa. This is a wonderful opportunity to share the Gospel outside of the camp setting, and it breaks up the 24/7 responsibilities you have as a cabin leader. You may also be assigned for a week or two to help out on support staff, as mentioned above. If you would like to be an adventure leader, you would have all of the same responsibilities as a cabin leader, except you would also get to be an adventure leader for 1-4 weeks during the summer. This consists of camping in tents, canoeing, rock climbing, and spending some quality time outdoors. There will be an adventure training camp out for all adventure leaders during training. Let us know if you have questions about any of these positions.
