Family camp check-in and other important stuff:

1. MOVING IN

As you drive into camp, you will be greeted by staff members who will get you checked in.



They will direct you to your cabin where you will have the opportunity to move in and get settled. First gathering will be at 4:45pm in the Chapel. **Please be prepared to provide any balance due as you check-in.

2. medications

Medical needs and medication administration will be the responsibility of the family. We do not have a medical volunteer on site for Family Camp however first aid supplies are available as needed.

3. Camp store

The camp store has a wide variety of candy, snack items, beverages, toiletries and plenty of Riverside apparel and gift items. You are welcome to pay with cash, check or credit card. If you'd like to begin a tab during your stay, we'll have you settle up at the end of the week.

4. art fun

During afternoon free time, there will be an opportunity for you to engage in some art and craft activities. There is a small fee for some of the activity options available.

5. HORSEBACK RIDES

Horseback rides are FREE during Family Camp! Family members can participate in this activity during the afternoon free time. A sign-up will be available at dinner on your first evening at camp. Everyone entering fourth grade and younger will receive an arena ride and all other ages will be eligible for a trail ride (weather permitting). **Closed toed shoes and jeans must be worn during horseback rides.

6. SLINGSHOT PAINTBALL

Slingshot paintball will be available to participants 11-years-old and older for FREE. You will have an opportunity to sign up at dinner on your first evening at camp. **Closed toed shoes and jeans must be worn during this activity.

7. SWIMMING

Our pool house has a family restroom, showers and storage cubbies. There are fun water slides and a rock-climbing wall. Kids less than 18 years of age will need to pass a deep end test to swim in and use the pool equipment located on the deep end of the pool.

For sure:


- Bible, pencil/pen, notebook
- Swimsuits and beach towels (one-piece suits for girls, no Speedos for boys)
- Jeans, shorts, warmer clothes, jacket, sweatshirt, rain clothes (No short shorts, tops should cover midsection, straps on tank tops should be at least two inches wide)
- Pajamas and underclothes
- · Tennis shoes, sandals, or old shoes
- Towel, washcloth, shampoo, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.
- Sleeping bag or sheets/blankets for twin size bed, pillow
- Sunscreen, bug repellent, flashlight
- Backpack or bag to carry things to/from cabin
- Waterproof bag for wet swimsuits/towels

Optional:

- Camera
- Books
- Camp store money
- Card table/chairs for your own use in your cabin
- Food/snacks if you bring food, please be certain it is stored in airtight containers so as to not attract any four-legged creatures!
- PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR BIKES.
 Also, you will not be able to lock your cabin so it is our suggestion that you do not bring expensive jewelry, electronics, etc.
